GOLDEN SLUMBERS

WHAT YOU NEED: Paper, pen or pencil

WHAT YOU DO:

- Give your child a piece of paper and a pen or pencil.
- Assign your child an even amount of money between \$1 and \$10. (Actual cash is not needed.)
- Challenge your child to do the number puzzle below.
 - Double the number of dollars you were assigned.
 - Add 6 to the new amount.
 - Divide that amount by 2.
 - Subtract the original amount of money you were assigned at the beginning
 - Multiply that amount by 100.
- Ask:
 - How much money did you end up with? (Note that your child should end up with \$300.)
 - What would you do with that amount of money?
 - How do the choices we make with our money show others what is important to us?



TALK ABOUT IT

Talk with your child about the Bible story. Use the following as a guide:

- In the story Jesus told, two servants doubled their money while their boss was away. But what did the third servant do with his bag of gold? (He buried it in the ground.)
- What are some choices you've made that came with some responsibility? (playing a sport, volunteering at school or church, getting a pet, etc.)
- Why do you think some people use their gifts and talents for good, and some don't? (laziness, busyness, not feeling confident, etc.)
- How important do you think it is to KNOW the gifts God has given you? Why?
- This week, what are some ways you can make the most of what God has given you?

Parent: Share a story about a time you used what you had to help someone else. Talk about how, as people who love Jesus, we have a responsibility to share His love with others.

PRAY

Dear God, thank You for giving us everything we need to live out Your plan for our lives. Help us remember that You always provide for us, and You take care of all of our needs. Please show us how to be responsible and make the most of what You've given us. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen
